PERSONAL INJURY Terms

Affidavit

Formal written statement declared under oath

Arbitration

Legal procedure which happens outside of the courts where parties dispute in front of a neutral arbitrator

Complaint

First formal action taken to begin a civil lawsuit which states the plaintiffs' allegations against the defendant

Defendant

Individual who is being sued for damages and losses

Deposition

Oral testimony under oath where one party questions the other party or witnesses

Discovery

Pretrial investigation where parties gather facts and information about the other party to build their case

Liability

Obligation bound to by law to perform, typically involving accepting responsibility for one's fault

Litigation

Process of taking legal action and/or filing a lawsuit

Personal Injury

Any physical or emotional injury excluding property damage

Plaintiff

Person who initiates the lawsuit or believes they suffered losses

Settlement Mediation

Dispute resolution method where a neutral third party mediator meets with both parties to reach a mutually satisfactory solution

Subrogation

The right held by most health insurance companies to legally recover the bills they paid in relation to a case

Trial

Examination of facts and law presided over by a judge

Underinsured Motorist

No fault coverage through insurance in the event someone else causes and accident with insufficient liability limits

Uninsured Motorist

No fault coverage through insurance in the event someone else causes an accident and they do not have insurance

Verdict

Decision of a jury after a trial, which must be accepted by the trial judge to be a final decision

Wrongful Death

Death that has been caused by the negligence of another person

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
